**Bee crazy:** Travelers to Provincia di Matera in the southern part of Italy can now get up close and personal with bees. 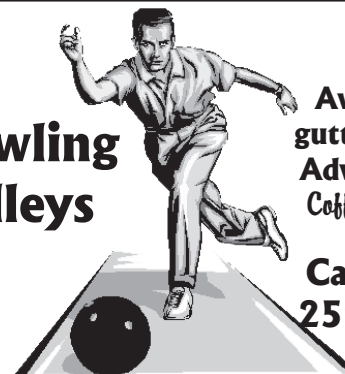

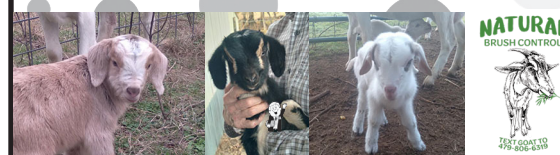

## Did You Know...
