Bee crazy: Travelers to Provincia di Matera in the southern part of Italy can now get up close and personal with bees. 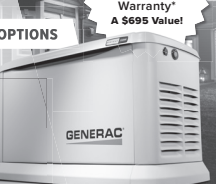
